

## ALTERNATIVES TO REGULAR COURSES AT GMHS

If a student (preferably a junior or senior) needs to take and pass a course but does not have room in the daily schedule for the class, some options are listed below.

1. Evening High School – These classes are held on the Leonardtown High School campus during first and second semester. Please check on the Evening High School Hot Topics section on our GMHS site.
2. Summer School – Summer school classes can only be taken if a student has already failed the class with at least an E. Registration usually begins in May.
3. Correspondence Courses – These courses are offered either through the mail or on-line and **students must receive approval from the counselor and principal to receive credit for these courses.** We typically use three correspondence schools but there are many more available on the internet.
