	Provide activities to help students make mathematical connections to real life situations.	Count with our child each day, and practice basic math facts as appropriate to our child's level. Involve our child in real world situations where math problem solving would apply.	Be actively involved in problem solving, listen carefully to instructions, and use hands-on materials to solve problems.
	Provide opportunities for students to participate in activities to develop reading strategies: summarizing, questioning, predicting, inferencing and clarifying.	Read together, provide coaching and sign the reading log each day.	Work with my coaches to achieve my reading goals and complete my reading log each day. Read for fun during my free time at my level.
