Greetings!

Beginning February 1, 2019, we will begin accepting registration and payment for AP testing. The deadline to register and order an AP test is March 22, 2019. AP testing will start on May 6, 2019 and finish on May 17, 2019. A list of the exam dates and times can be found in the *AP Bulletin for Students and Parents*. The *AP Bulletin for Students and Parents* was distributed along with this letter. A copy can also be found on the school website as well as the College Board website. The *AP Bulletin for Students and Parents* and the College Board website (<https://www.collegeboard.org/>) contain important information, dates, and times. AP tests are \$94 each. **AP Seminar & AP Research are the only two exceptions. They cost \$142 each.** There is no actual test for AP Research but students who wish to have their papers submitted to the College Board can register and pay to have them submitted. The cost for this is \$142. Students who receive free/reduced lunch will have their fee subsidized and can take AP tests free of charge.

AP Test Fees

Each AP test costs \$94.00

(Only exception is AP Seminar & AP Research which are \$142)
