Our Community, Our School

Leonardtown High School is located in St. Mary's County, "where the Potomac meets the Chesapeake." As the oldest county in Maryland, St. Mary's is filled with rich history such as lighthouses, Civil War sites, and monuments commemorating our African-American heritage. Our current population stands strong at 109,000. As a county that supports the U.S. Navy, we continue to have an influx of growth.

Leonardtown High School is the largest of three public high schools in St. Mary's County. Our population is 1,875. We are a comprehensive school offering preparatory programs, and programs designed to prepare students for business and technical occupations. Our school is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and the Maryland State Department of Education. Our Curriculum

- Beginning school year 2013, year-long classes versus former semester style classes

Forrest Career and Technology Center offers diverse programs: Academy of Health Professions, Criminal Justice, Productions Engineering, and the Building Trades to name a few.
- Levels of classes include: Standard, Certificate of Merit (CM)/College Prep, Honors and Advanced Placement
- Concurrent enrollment with College of Southern Maryland gives opportunity for unlimited accumulation of college credit
- Class rank is determined by weighted GPA
